This well stocked organ was installed here in the eastern gallery in 1923, and has been in regular use until the church closed recently. The church is anxious to find a new home for the instrument.

Some black buttons and aluminium squares indicate overhaul at some point. The pedal action and some of the pipework is ailing; a general renovation is now needed to restore this fine historic instrument with its classical mid 19th century stop list. Holt had the reputation of producing high quality work.

The building with all its contents, including the pipe organ, is to be sold by public auction on 28th August 2012.

As time is short, please let the church contact know at once of your interest. This information will then be presented to the new owners with a strong recommendation that the organ be preserved.
